FAQ

1. Why audition?

Anyone wishing to be on a competitive team must audition.

Specific advanced classes require an audition as well (see class schedule).

All Studio A pre-team and team dancers will be required to take 5 hours of dance per week. Most teams train 4 hours per week: one additional hour of dance will be required. Pre-teams train 2 hours per week: 3 additional hours of dance will be required. The additional hour(s) may be chosen by the dancer to complement his/her team training.

2. Should I register for classes I want to take before the results of the auditions are known? Yes. Please register for the classes you would like to take to secure your spot in the class. You may change your schedule if necessary after you know your audition results. (If you wait for your audition results- the class you want may fill up, and you may be put on a waiting list.)

3. If I absolutely must miss the auditions- what do I do?

It is very important that you make every attempt to make the Auditions. If due to extreme conditions you are not able to be present, please notify the office.

4. Is there a fee for auditions?

Yes - there is a \$20.00 audition fee.

5. How do I register?

You may call and leave a phone message, email, or come to the office at 205 Frobisher, Pointe-Claire during office hours, Mon - Thurs 4pm-8pm.

We will need your name, age and phone number. If you register by phone or email you may pay when you arrive for the audition.

6. Why is arrival time 30 minutes before the actual audition?

You will need to allow yourself the proper time to check-in and fill out the audition registration form. Please arrive on time.

7. Should I bring anything to the auditions?

Yes, a water bottle and light snack if you desire.

8. Are parents allowed to stay and watch?

Parents will be allowed to assist their dancer with the registration process (if necessary), however, since space is limited, parents will be asked to leave during the audition process.

9. How do auditions work?

After everyone has signed in, the studio director and judges will give opening remarks. There will be a group warm-up, and you will be taught a short choreography. You will be given some time to practice and review. Dancers will be called to audition in groups of 6-8. The group will be given a few 8 counts of music to "free-style", then perform the choreography and finish with another few 8 counts of "free-style". Each group of dancers may be asked to repeat the process so that the judges may evaluate each of the dancers in the group.

10. Will the auditions last the entire time listed?

This will depend on the number of dancers registered. It is important to arrive on time. We will begin on time.

11. What if I have other questions?

It's important that you understand the audition process. If you have any questions pertaining to the auditions, please contact the studio.
